Target Participants	Primary and secondary school students	
Outline	<p>Training covers basic football techniques including dribbling, handling, crossing and shooting. Also, basic defense and attack tactics, formations and rules and regulations would be introduced in groups.</p> <p>Students with potential can be identified through the programme so as to form school team for long term development as well as to enhance the level of the sport among students.</p>	<p>Training mainly covers skills and tactics, with emphasis on the individual skill and team work. The purpose is to train up students to form school teams for participation in football competitions.</p> <p>Each school may apply for continuous training for its school team of a maximum of 16 students. The list of school team members must be submitted to the LCSD at the beginning of the academic term. Coaches will assess their skills regularly during the training sessions.</p>

Football is available under the Sport Captain Programme. Please refer to the respective prospectus for details. (P.184)</li> <li>4. If the NSA has arranged a coach for a school and the school requests before the activity date the cancellation of the activity, NSA will deduct from the fee for each activity an administrative fee (\$194 per Sport Demonstration; \$388 per training course under the Outreach Coaching Programme) and refund the balance to the school.</li> <li>5. If the NSA/LCSD fails to arrange the activity, the fees paid will be refunded.</li> </ol>
