Joint Schools Rowing Training Programme (Galaxy Star 2-3)

2023/2024 Prospectus

Purpose	Provide continuous and systematic training for students with potential and aspiration to develop in rowing by enhancing their rowing skills.
Eligibility	(a) Participants should be able to swim 50 metres with clothes on; and (b) Participates should have reached a skill level of Star 1.
Target Participants	Secondary school students
Course Outline	(a) Students will learn more about the Code of Safety for Rowers and the stretching and warm-up exercises specifically for rowing. (b) Students will learn the basic skills of rowing with the use of indoor rowing machines, and receive physical training. (c) Students will master rowing skills on water with the use of double rowing simulators. (d) Students will be taught various rowing skills, including inter alia shoving off, rowing forward, turning, stopping, backwatering, rotating and berthing, with the use of recreation craft. Before the end of the course, the coach(es) will conduct a skill test for the students. Students meeting the required skill level will be awarded the “Certificate of Galaxy Star 3” from the HKCRA, and may receive further training on recommendation from the coach(es).
Training Venue	Jockey Club Sha Tin Rowing Centre or Jockey Club Shek Mun Rowing Centre
Fee	\$320 per person
Duration	20 hours per course (Can be divided into 5 sessions of 4 hours each according to activity arrangement. Students are advised to complete the training course within 5 consecutive weeks.)
Quota	8 per group A maximum of 2 training courses for each student in the same school year
Proposed Time of Activity	Monday to Friday: 9 am to 6:30 pm or Saturday and Sunday: 9 am to 6 pm

Notes of Enrolment	<p>(a) The applicant should apply <u>in his/her own capacity</u> and have the enrolment form stamped by the school.</p> <p>(b) The rowing training course will be conducted at the Jockey Club Sha Tin Rowing Centre or Jockey Club Shek Mun Rowing Centre under the HKCRA. The practice date and time will be arranged by the HKCRA or co-ordinated with the students. If you have enquiries about the activity date, please contact the staff of the HKCRA on 2696 2337 or 3841 7351.</p> <p>(c) Students must submit the applications, each with a cheque of the relevant amount (made payable to "Hong Kong, China Rowing Association"), by post to the office of the Hong Kong, China Rowing Association, Jockey Club Sha Tin Rowing Centre, No. 27 Yuen Wo Road, Sha Tin N.T. one and a half months before the commencement of the activity. Please mark on the envelope "Joint Schools Rowing Training Programme (Galaxy Star 2-3)".</p> <p>(d) The organiser reserves the right to cancel the course in case of insufficient enrolment.</p> <p>(e) The activity will be cancelled in the event of school suspension announced by the Education Bureau or the following severe weather conditions:</p> <p>(1) The Hong Kong Observatory issues the Strong Monsoon Warning Signal, Thunderstorm Warning Signal, Tropical Cyclone Warning Signal No. 1 or above, or Amber Rainstorm Warning Signal or above two hours before the activity; or</p> <p>(2) If the Environmental Protection Department announces that the Air Quality Health Index recorded by general stations reaches the "serious" level (i.e. 10+), outdoor activities in the affected areas must be stopped immediately.</p> <p>(f) There is no refund for all cancelled classes. Subject to the availability of the venue, the HKCRA will arrange make-up lessons as far as possible.</p>
Remarks	Participants should wear proper sportswear and sports shoes for the training course.
